

Luis Ostrosky-Zeichner, MD, FACP, FIDSA, FECMM, FSHEA, CMQ.

Dr. Ostrosky-Zeichner is a professor of medicine and epidemiology, the vice-chair of Medicine for Healthcare Quality, the director of the Laboratory of Mycology Research, and the Division Chief at the Division of Infectious Diseases of the McGovern Medical School. He also serves as medical director for epidemiology and stewardship for Memorial Hermann Hospital Texas Medical Center. He has consulted for the FDA and the CDC. He has published over 180 peer-reviewed articles and actively pursues translational and clinical research in medical mycology and hospital epidemiology. His areas of expertise include antifungal susceptibility testing, sero-diagnostics, PK/PD of antifungals, in vivo models of human mycoses, immunology, and clinical trials in prophylaxis and treatment of fungal infections, transplant infectious diseases, as well as hospital epidemiology, antimicrobial stewardship, and infection control. He has been coordinating the COVID-19 response at UTHealth and Memorial Hermann TMC since this outbreak began in early 2020.
